

Seven Things To Do Daily
Perform your Vows Daily
Psalm 61.8; Eccl 5.1-6

*Psalm 61:8 - So will I sing praise unto thy name for ever, **that I may daily perform my vows.***

*Ecclesiastes 5:1–6 - Keep thy foot when thou goest to the house of God, and **be more ready to hear,** than to give the sacrifice of fools: for they consider not that they do evil. **²Be not rash with thy mouth, and let not thine heart be hasty to utter any thing before God:** for God is in heaven, and thou upon earth: **therefore let thy words be few.** ³For a dream cometh through the multitude of business; and a fool's voice is known by multitude of words. **⁴When thou vowest a vow unto God, defer not to pay it;** for he hath no pleasure in fools: pay that which thou hast vowed. ⁵Better is it that thou shouldest not vow, than that thou shouldest vow and not pay. **⁶Suffer not thy mouth to cause thy flesh to sin; neither say thou before the angel, that it was an error:** wherefore should God be angry at thy voice, and destroy the work of thine hands?*

What does it mean to keep our vows?

*Ecclesiastes 5:4–7 - **When thou vowest a vow unto God, defer not to pay it;** for he hath no pleasure in fools: **pay that which thou hast vowed.** ⁵Better is it that thou shouldest **not vow,** than that thou shouldest **vow and not pay.** **⁶Suffer not thy mouth to cause thy flesh to sin; neither say thou before the angel, that it was an error:** wherefore should God be angry at thy voice, and destroy the work of thine hands? ⁷For in the multitude of dreams and many words there are also divers vanities: but fear thou God.*

A vow is what you have pledged that you would do. A vow is your word.

I was always taught that a man is only as good as his word.

Psalm 15 LORD, who shall abide in thy tabernacle? who shall dwell in thy holy hill? ²He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the truth in his heart. ³He that backbiteth not with his tongue, nor doeth evil to his neighbour, nor taketh up a reproach against his neighbour.

⁴In whose eyes a vile person is contemned; but he honoureth them that fear the LORD. **He that sweareth to his own hurt, and changeth not.** ⁵He that putteth not out his money to usury, nor taketh reward against the innocent. He that doeth these things shall never be moved.

The Vows people make. Some people make vows,

- After reading and studying their Bible
- During or after hearing a convicting and convincing Sermon
- When the Holy Spirit moves in their life
- During difficult circumstances

Seven Vows of King David Psalm 116

Psalm 116:1–2 - I love the LORD, **because he hath heard my voice and my supplications.** ²Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon him as long as I live.

1. I will walk before the Lord (vs 9) - I will walk before the LORD in the land of the living. – This is to live God's way. Die to self, take up your cross.

Ephesians 4:1 - I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, **beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called,**

2. Render unto the Lord for His Benefits (vs 12) – This is to give back willingly to God. **We give back to God in our,**

- Time

Hebrews 10:25 - Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

- **Treasures** – Malachi 3.7-12

Malachi 3:8 - Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

Seven Vows of King David

1. **O will walk before the Lord – Die Daily**
2. **Render unto the Lord for His Benefits – Give back to God.**

- **Talents**

Matthew 25:14–19 - For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods. ¹⁵And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey. ¹⁶Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made them other five talents. ¹⁷And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two. ¹⁸But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money. ¹⁹After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them.

Matthew 25:21 - His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

3. Took up the Cup of Salvation (vs 12-13) – To live the redeemed life

*Psalm 116:12–13 - What shall I render unto the LORD for all his benefits toward me? ¹³**I will take the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the LORD.***

Living the life of a child of God will make you different from the world around us.

Titus 2:14 - Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

4. Call upon the Name of the Lord (vs 1-2,13)

Psalm 116:1–2 - I love the LORD, because he hath heard my voice and my supplications. ²Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon him as long as I live.

Psalm 116:13 - I will take the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the LORD.

This is to pray or to talk with God continually

5. Live for the Lord Publicly (vs 14) – Never be a covert Christian

Psalm 116:14 - I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people.

6. Offer Thanksgiving to the Lord (vs 17)

Psalm 116:17 - I will offer to thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will call upon the name of the LORD.

7. I will pay my vows unto the Lord (vs 18-19)

Psalm 116:18–19 - I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people, ¹⁹In the courts of the LORD'S house, in the midst of thee, O Jerusalem. Praise ye the LORD.
